Important Reminders:

If another adult is collecting your child at the end of session, please inform your child's teacher or contact the school office. A password is required. Adults must be over the age of eighteen years old to collect children from nursery.

At nursery, we promote independence. Your child will be encouraged to take off their own coat and hang up their belongings on their peg. Please remind and encourage your child of this routine. Staff will be present to support your child if required.

If your child is toilet training, please ensure you share efforts with staff to ensure consistency for your child. Please provide a bag including pants, socks, trousers, wipes and nappies or pull-ups, so your child can be changed if required.
