## This term in class we are learning about...

In History, we are studying 'Stone Age to Iron Age'. The children will focus on 'Settlements in Society' for this topic and will look at housing, Skara Brea, Stonehenge and roundhouses found in the Iron Age.

In Geography, we will begin the year developing our knowledge of maps of the world. We will explore the Equator, the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn along with the Eastern and Western Hemispheres. We will become familiar with the Prime Meridian and lines of Longitude and Latitude.

In D&T, our focus is Frame Structures. Within this project, children will explore the theory of triangulation and will use their knowledge to design, create and evaluate frame structures.

#### Homework:

All children will continue to receive online homework for maths and spelling. This will be set on a Monday and must be completed by a Friday each week.
